COVID-19 Curfew Travel Notice for BHB Employees:

In response to COVID-19 infection numbers, the Government of Bermuda will institute a curfew from Thursday 23 December 2021.

As BHB is an essential service, BHB employees travelling to and from work during the curfew hours are permitted to travel on Bermuda's roads. Should you be stopped by security officials, please present your BHB employee ID and a valid driving licence. You can also provide this letter.

If you are driven to and from work by someone who is not a BHB employee, your driver is covered by your employee ID. Should they be stopped by security officials after they have dropped you off at work, or if your driver is travelling to pick you up from work, they should advise the official they are transporting an essential services employee to and from work. They should also provide this letter as evidence.

Employees are reminded that during the curfew, they can only use their employee IDs to travel to and from work and should not use them in any other circumstances.

We thank you for your dedication to BHB, and appreciate the support and service that you provide to our organisation, and to our patients.
